RULES AND PROCEDURES

The competition is open for students pursuing bachelor's or master's degree from any UGC recognized educational institution.

Interested participants have to register for this competition by paying the registration fee and completing the procedure. Any kind of discrepancy in the registration process may lead to rejection of the request for registration as has been done in the past.

The quiz will contain only multiple-choice questions, and will be conducted through Google Forms.

Quiz will contain 30 questions. The quiz will consist of interesting questions related to basics of criminal law, current affairs, fun facts and Criminal Legislations of IPC, CrPC and Indian Evidence Act. Each question will fetch 1 mark.

All the participants are expected to complete and submit the quiz within the specified time, i.e. 15 minutes, failing which, the link would automatically turn inactive and the participants would find themselves unable to submit their responses.

The quiz will be conducted online via a link that we would be sending to you on the email ID that you would register with us through the registration form. The exact timings shall be intimated to all the participants in advance.

Students can participate in the Quiz through Mobiles, Tablets, Laptops, and Desktops which have internet connectivity. There will be no negative marking.

RESULTS : After commencement of quiz, the individual score sheets will be communicated to participants through respective mail id's. The final rankings shall be announced on CRCJ Instagram page - @crcj_mnl and on the official site of CRCJ and on the official facebook and LinkedIn page. The participant shall receive certificate of merits and certification of participation on their respective mail id's.

The organizers reserve the right to disqualify participants for deviating from the Rules. The organizers will resolve any contingencies that may arise and will be the final arbiters regarding any doubts/grievances. The decision taken by the organizers shall be final.
